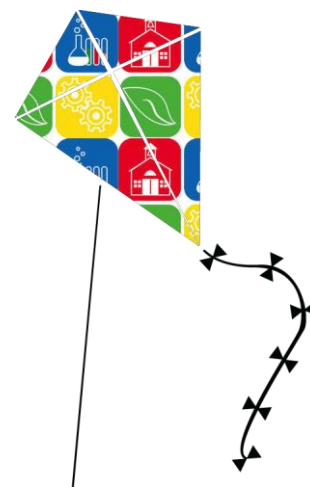
## Timeline

## **Qualifications for School-Wide Science Super Star Recognition**

- **Goals need to be complete and form sent** to Community Resources for Science (1611 San Pablo Ave. Suite 10 B | Berkeley, CA 94702) by **March 31, 2012**
- **School** must also submit **at least one learning anecdote** (student writing or work, something a teacher writes, or video or photos of a science experience in class)

  - **Whole School Membership in CRS** – You’ve already done that, and thanks to our grant partners this is at no cost to most of our member schools!
  - **80% of all classrooms** at the school **complete the requirements** for a Science Super Star School
  - **Every student** has read (or had read to them) **at least one age-appropriate, science-based fiction or non-fiction book or article**. (Examples: See our science lit list at <http://www.crscience.org/educators/scienceliterature> )
  - **Every student** has completed **at least two science based writing pieces** (science journals, research write-ups, summary of science books read....)
  - **Each teacher** participates in **group science planning time**. (This could be a faculty meeting with some time dedicated to science or grade level planning teams working on science planning)
  - **Each teacher** has made **at least one request for science planning support from CRS**
    - Asked for personalized resource reports (websites, education programs, professional development workshops, sample materials) **or**
    - Requested personalized planning time with a CRS staff member **or**
    - Requested BASIS volunteer presentation **or**
    - Logged onto and used CRS online database <http://www.crscience.org/database/>



**Rewards & Recognitions:** In addition to great science learning,

- Science Super Star School Recognition Certificate, and award badge for school website
- Science Super Star Stickers for all students
- A school-wide popsicle party (or similar treat)
- Entry into a drawing to receive a free assembly, garden kits, and other prizes for the school.
- Recognition on the CRS website, CRS e-NewsBlasts, and CRS Newsletter.
